

Psalms 139 – David’s Psalm

Psalms breaks down into five segments:

1. Genesis 1-41
2. Exodus 42-72
3. Leviticus 73-89
4. Numbers 90-106
5. Deuteronomy 107-150

1. Man in face of God’s Omniscience v. 1-6

“Am I a God near at hand,’ says the LORD, ‘And not a God afar off?’”
(Jeremiah 23:23 NKJV)

- God knows you more intimately than you know yourself
- God knows when you are going to take a nap
- God knows words before spoken
- Wherever he turns he is in God’s power
- God knows the important and unimportant
- How can God know and control things so absolutely?

*“Oh, the depth of the riches both of the wisdom and knowledge of God!
How unsearchable are His judgments and His ways past finding out!”*
(Rom 11:33 NKJV)

2. Man in face of God’s Omnipresence v.7-12

You can’t get out of God’s reach (His presence, His Spirit)

“Though they dig into hell, From there My hand shall take them; Though they climb up to heaven, From there I will bring them down;” (Amos 9:2 NKJV)

Even Hell knows His presence. Ex. Jonah
Wherever we go east or west His is light. He is never in darkness.

3. Man as Work of God’s hands - Ominpotent v. 13-18

(Adam skillful brought out of earth)

Ex. Stages of prenatal development.

God has a book of divine foreknowledge
(book of life – book of deeds)

Ex. Numbers of hairs on head

God’s thoughts concerning me cannot be numbered

One can never be out of God’s presence

Each day I awake with Him

4. God is Omni-righteous v. 19-22

Man needs to know God can overthrow the wicked

The Way Everlasting

“Search me, O God, and know my heart; Try me, and know my anxieties; And see if there is any wicked way in me, And lead me in the way everlasting.” (Ps 139:23-24 NKJV)
